

2009/2010 School Fees and Financial Information

Bucharest Christian Academy was founded upon and is committed to a Christian-based English language education primarily for the children of missionaries and Christian expatriates serving in Romania. Children from all families are encouraged to apply.

BCA is a non-profit Romanian Foundation. The Board has set its registration and tuition fees as low as possible to make Christian education as affordable as possible for all of its families.

Registration Fees

A non-refundable registration fee is required for each student wishing to be enrolled. Pre-Registration is open until May 22, 2009. The pre-registration fee is \$125 per child. Regular registration begins May 25, 2009, and the fee is \$150 per child.

Tuition Rate (*per semester*) is as follows:

To apply for the Missionary Scholarship Rate, you must submit a letter to BCA's Director from your sending mission or church board stating that you are serving in Romania as a full time missionary. (If you have a current letter on file with BCA it is not necessary to resubmit a letter for the 2009/2010 school year.) Any questions should be addressed to the Director.

The oldest child enrolled is considered the first child. For a family serving with one of BCA's Sponsoring Mission Agencies (SMA), there is an additional 10% scholarship.

ESL (English as a Second Language) Fees

BCA is providing an ESL program for the 2009/2010 school year for all students needing supplementary education in the English language to enable them to work at their grade level. There is an additional \$250 fee per semester per child to participate in this program.

NILD

A \$50 fee for materials will be charged for each child enrolled in the NILD program.

Secondary Sports

There will be a \$50 fee required for each student participating in secondary sports—payable the first week of practice. There will only be one fee per child, regardless of the number of sports participated in for the year. Transportation costs for the Budapest basketball trip will be the responsibility of each participant.

Building Fee

A one-time \$5000 building fee will be assessed per child. This fee is payable the first semester of enrollment. Those paying their own tuition expenses may request a waiver.

Payment Deadlines

Application and Pre-Registration fee of \$125 is due by May 22, 2009. Tuition fees for the 1st semester are due on or before Friday, September 11, 2009. Tuition fees for the 2nd semester are due on or before Friday, January 15, 2010. A late fee of \$50 per child will be charged for tuition not fully paid by this date.

If a student enrolls during the second half of the semester the tuition fee will be pro-rated on a per-diem basis. All tuition fees are non-refundable.

If you anticipate any difficulty in meeting the payment deadlines please discuss this with the Director. **No partial payments will be accepted without the Director's signature.**

Method of Payment

Payment of fees may be made by any one of the following methods:

- 1. Wire Transfer to ECCU (US credit union)**
- 2. Payment by U.S. Bank Check**
- 3. Cash in RON (*US dollars cannot be accepted*)**
